

## 2021-2022 Illinois School Health Requirements for Middle School / Info

**A) Required PHYSICAL EXAM:** The physical can be performed by a physician, physician assistant, or advanced practice nurse.

- New students enrolling in an Illinois school for the 1<sup>st</sup> time.
- Incoming 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

**NOTE:**

<sup>a</sup> Physical exam must be complete within one year of the start of school. (Example: for the 2021-2022 school year, the physical must be dated after August 15, 2020)

**This is an Illinois State Requirement. If we do not receive this form or immunization are non-compliant, your student will be subject to exclusion from school on Monday, September 13, 2021.**

**B) Required IMMUNIZATIONS:**

- New students enrolling in an Illinois school for the 1<sup>st</sup> time.
- Incoming 6<sup>th</sup> Grade
- 1 Meningococcal Meningitis vaccine given on or after 11th birthday.
- 1 Tdap vaccine (6th through 12th)
- 2 Varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccines OR immunity proof (6th through 12th)
- Proof of 2 doses of MMR
- 3 Hepatitis B vaccines (proof the series has been completed)

**C) DENTAL EXAM:**

- Incoming 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

**NOTE:**

<sup>a</sup> Proof of Dental exam must be submitted by May 15, 2022.

<sup>b</sup> The exam must have taken place within 18 months prior to May 15, 2022 (Example: For the May 15, 2022 deadline, the exam can be dated after November 15, 2021)

**D) HEARING SCREENING**

Required on the following students:

- Transfer students
- Students who are referred by a teacher.

**E) VISION SCREENING**

Required on the following students:

- 8<sup>th</sup> grade students
- Students who are referred by a teacher.
