Health Forms



Dear Parent or Guardian,

We are excited that you are the next class coming into Peoria Christian High School. There are a few mandatory forms and details that must be taken care of in a timely manner in order to facilitate a smooth transition into high school.

1. State of Illinois Child Health Examination Form:

- All incoming freshman and any student new to an Illinois school must submit a physical dated within one year of the school start date and be on file by the start date of school.
- If entering during the school year, a complete 9th grade physical must be on file with the school within 10 days of acceptance into school.
- Parent/Guardian must complete and sign Health History section of physical.
- All immunizations must be up to date with Illinois state requirements. <u>http://dph.illinois.gov/topics-services/prevention-wellness/immunization</u>

- This is an Illinois State Requirement. If we do not receive this form or immunizations are noncompliant your student will be subject to exclusion from school on Sept 11.
- 10th & 12th grade: Must have two (2) doses of meningococcal conjugate vaccine.
- If playing a fall sport, physicals need to be turned in before or on first day of try-outs. All HS athletes must have a physical (9th grade or sports physical) on the first day of try-outs.
- 2. State of Illinois required Dental Form
 - > 9th graders are required to submit a state dental examination form.
